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This Workbook contains all the necessary information to be assessed to submit a Recognition of Prior Learning/Current Competence (RPL) Application form through the Club Secretary to the Administrator NZ High Performance Coaching Commission. In order to submit this application, **ALL** elements in this checklist **MUST** be completed.



SECTION 1: Application Check List

Application completed All details must be recorded on the application and it must be signed by the Club Secretary, hence confirming NZFRS Registration.
NZFRS Registration Fee Paid and current Applicant must be a current registered member of New Zealand Federation of Roller Sports Inc (SkateNZ) and a member of an affiliated Club. (Club Secretary signing Application form will confirm the above.)

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Application Form

This form asks you to provide information about yourself and the knowledge and skills that are the basis of your application for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).

The form contains two sections:

- SECTION 1: General information about yourself and the specific details of your RPL application.
- SECTION 2: Information about how your experience relates to your RPL application.
- A. After completing this application form, you may be invited to attend an interview at which point you will have the opportunity to support your application.
- B. There are many ways that a person can show evidence of current competencies.

 RPL can only be granted on current evidence, that is, work that has been completed within the last four years and competencies that are currently able to be demonstrated. Following are a few examples of the ways evidence can be provided. You will need to include a variety of these in your application.
 - Coaching Related Experiences
 - Education and Training
 - Life Experiences
 - And many more

SECTION 2 - Summary of Experience

Relevant information for this section can include:

- · education or training details;
- current and former work experience;
- your interests and skills (e.g. parental skills, involvement in school committees, organising a family business/accounts, involvement in hobby groups and childcare responsibilities);
- membership of professional associations;
- conference attendances;
- bilingual or multilingual skills;
- Community involvement/voluntary work.

Please attach evidence to verify the items claimed in this section. Evidence may include:

- · Resume of coaching experience and positions held, which may include reports from people within the sport.
- Copies of any statements, references or articles about your coaching employment or community involvement.
- Relevant coaching samples, e.g. copies of training programs, videos of coaching tools, which you have developed and implemented.
- · Reports on opportunities undertaken, which could include evaluations from training programs conducted.
- Overview of sport and recreation involvement.
- Formal, accredited and information training.
- Copies of certificates, qualifications achieved from other training programs, school or tertiary results.
- Statements outlining training programs and or study that you have undertaken and the learning outcomes/competencies achieved from these.
- Evidence of home/self-directed study which may include a list of recent readings, synopsis of seminars attended, reports of research or analysis undertaken.

The above are only examples. You should provide all the documents that clearly shows evidence of the competencies you hold.
