The DC Sportsmanship Award

The true meaning of sportsmanship is behaving ethically towards others, being fair and reasonable to opponents and humble when competing. This award is to celebrate a skater who has shown these qualities in the sport of artistic roller skating. The emphasis is not placed on the skaters personal skating ability but instead their sportsmanship towards their own skating, other skaters and officials.

Nominations must be completed by coaches, officials or other skaters (non-relatives). They should include a brief description of how the skater has demonstrated these qualities over the past year. Nominations close <u>at 5.00pm, 15 June 2024</u>. The award will be presented at the closing ceremony of the New Zealand Artistic Championships.
